GULL-BILLED TERN IN TENNESSEE

Gull-billed Terns (*Gelochilodon nilotica*) nesting in the eastern United States are confined exclusively to coastal areas. These birds nest in May or June in colonies with other terns, frequently on barren beaches. After breeding, most eastern U.S. birds migrate to the southeastern states while some continue on to Central or South America for the winter. The species is not globally threatened, but with an estimated world population of 55,000 pairs (del Hoyo et al. 1996), it is not abundant anywhere. The eastern United States population was reduced by egg collectors and plume hunters in the early 1900s, and only 1500 pairs were found on a 1984 census (del Hoyo et al. 1996).

Any inland records of Gull-billed Tern are noteworthy. This note provides details of two separate individuals observed in Tennessee in recent years.

On the morning of 22 May 2004 Mike Todd was birding in Dyer County, Tennessee near the junction of Tennessee State Highway 103 and the Great River Road. He observed an adult Gull-billed Tern hunting over an adjacent field. All appropriate field marks were noted, but no photos were obtained. Mike was able to study the bird for about 15 minutes before it flew off to the south. Despite an extensive search by Mike and several other birders, the tern was never seen again (Mike Todd, personal correspondence). This record was accepted by the Tennessee Bird Records Committee (Todd 2005) and placed on the Provisional section of the state list.

On 26 May 2006 Jeff Cowell and I were birding at Kingston Steam Plant in Roane County. At about 1700 EDT we were on the west bank of the largest ash pond scanning a flock of about 100 shorebirds, most of which were White-rumped Sandpipers (*Calidris fuscicollis*), when we noted the approach from the north of what appeared to be a mostly white bird with tern-like flight. As it flew closer, we

at this time and continued careful documentation of any nesting and breeding season observations is critical (Nicholson 1997). It is also unknown whether these observations are related to the existence of the CP33 field border program. This report provides additional information on this secretive species in Tennessee and points to the possibility that the CP33 program could provide some benefit to this typically wetland species. Additional field observations, which were not possible during this study, are recommended to follow up any future observations during the nesting period.

MINUTES OF THE 2006 TOS SPRING MEETING

The Tennessee Ornithological Society's (TOS) 2006 Spring Meeting was hosted by the Nashville Chapter of TOS at the Ellington Agricultural Center in Nashville, 5-7 May 2006. Field trips were offered to Beaman Park, Natchez Trace, Radnor Lake, and Shelby Bottoms. President Danny Gaddy called the Directors' meeting to order at 3:20 p.m. Laura McCall, acting as interim secretary, announced that a quorum had been met. The minutes from the Fall Meeting, held 1 October 2005, were distributed for review. Van Harris made the motion to approve the minutes with minor corrections. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

The Nashville Chapter of TOS was thanked for their hospitality and excellent planning of the meeting. Nashville TOS Chapter President Susan Hollyday recognized Amy Potter, Jon Mann, Ed Gleaves, Linda Kelly, and Janet McKendrick for their hard work in making the meeting a success.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Treasurer Mac McWhirter presented the Statement of Revenues and Expenses for the Year Ended 31 December 2005 (Tables 1 and 2) and the Statement of Revenues for the Four Months Ended 30 April 2006, which have been filed in the Secretary's records. He also gave the TOS 2005 Membership Report (Table 3; filed in Secretary's records).

FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT: The committee requested the approval of the Board of Directors to authorize the Chair of the Finance Committee and /or the TOS Treasurer to act upon recommendations of the Finance Committee to make adjustments to investment allocations without convening a meeting of the Board of Directors. To that end, Mac McWhirter proposed the following resolution:

That Ron Hoff, as Chair of Finance Committee, and/or N.P. McWhirter, Treasurer, be authorized to establish or close banking and investment accounts, and be authorized to execute buy, sell, or trade transactions for investments of TOS, based upon actions taken by the Finance Committee.

Charlie Muise made a motion to adopt the resolution. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved by the directors.

CONSERVATION AND RESEARCH FUND COMMITTEE REPORT: Charlie Muise reported that, to date, one grant application has been received. Grant guidelines and application form are available on the TOS website; the deadline is one week prior to the Fall Meeting. Grant awards will be announced at the Fall Meeting. The committee requests members' help in soliciting grant applications for "projects that will directly or indirectly help to protect the birds of Tennessee, increase scientific knowledge, or educate others about the importance of Tennessee's birds."

The Committee has received updates on research funded by past grants. There will be a vacancy on this committee, as the Muises will be moving to Georgia, but Charlie will stay on the committee through this round of grants.

Mac McWhirter made a motion to allocate up to \$3000, an increase of \$500, for the 2006 Conservation and Research Fund. The question was raised whether these funds could be used for land acquisition for conservation. Chuck Nicholson said current award wording would allow grants to be used for that purpose. The motion to increase the fund allocation was seconded and unanimously approved.

CONSERVATION POLICY COMMITTEE REPORT: Charlie Muise, reporting for committee Chair Melinda Welton, reported on the activities of the committee in the past year. (Statement of Conservation Policy Committee Activities Since May 2005 attached.) There will be a vacancy on this committee due to the Muises's relocation, effective after this meeting.

Summary of TOS Conservation Policy Committee Activities since May 2005

- 1) TOS has joined the Tennessee Teaming with Wildlife Coalition, organized by TWRA, to urge Congress to support for increased funding for wildlife through the State Wildlife Grants program and for wildlife funding to be included in any potential climate change legislation.
- 2) TOS submitted comments to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services in favor of the proposed delisting of the Bald Eagle and adoption of the National Bald Eagle Management Guidelines. These guidelines strengthen the Bald and Golden Eagle Protection Act, which augments protections offered by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act.
- 3) TOS sent letters to the entire TN Delegation expressing our strong opposition to efforts to weaken the Threatened and Endangered Species Act.
- 4) TOS signed-on to letters on the following topics as members of the Bird Conservation Alliance
 - To FCC Commissioners urging them to take action to prevent avian mortality at communication towers
 - In support of the reauthorization of the Migratory Bird Conservation Improvement Act
 - Opposing the changes to the Endangered Species Act sponsored by Rep. Pombo
- 5) TOS sent a letter to Governor Bredesen
 - thanking him for providing \$10 million to the Tennessee Heritage Trust Fund for land acquisition and for supporting the acquisition of high-priority portions of Bowater's lands,

- thanking him for making State Parks more accessible for the public by canceling entrance fees,
 - thanking him for the appointments of Jim Fyke as Director and Paul Sloan as Deputy Commissioner of the TN Department of Environment and Conservation, and
 - asking him to request that the U.S. Office of Surface Mining conduct a comprehensive statewide review of the environmental issues surrounding coal mining.
- 6) TOS submitted comments to the USFWS in support of adopting Alternative D for the Comprehensive Conservation Plans for Reelfoot, Lake Isom, Lower Hatchie, Chickasaw and Hatchie National Wildlife Refuges. Alternative D offered the most meaningful improvements in wildlife conservation and habitat management while still affording the public reasonable recreational opportunities.

The Committee reminded us to contact committee members to inform them of conservation issues and also to take individual action on issues of concern.

President's comments on committee vacancies: Two positions on the Conservation Policy Committee are opening up (one vacated by Charlie Muise, one vacated by Susan McWhirter), and President Gaddy encouraged members to speak to him if they know of someone who would be a good match for this committee. Charlie added that persons nominated for this committee need not necessarily be limited to birders currently active at TOS state-level meetings; more important is that a nominee be someone who keeps up with conservation issues and is good with correspondence. The Conservation and Research Fund Committee will also have an opening (vacated by Charlie Muise after the current round of grants). While a scientific background is certainly helpful in serving on this committee, Charlie stressed that someone with less scientific experience can still be very effective if they are not afraid to ask lots of questions. President Gaddy will make appointments to fill these vacancies and welcomes suggestions for good candidates.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE REPORT: The Nominating Committee (Van Harris, JoAnn Routledge, and Linda Kelly) put forward Richard Connors as their choice for President Elect and Laura McCall for Secretary. The general membership will vote on these choices at the annual meeting later in the evening.

Appointments have been made to the Publications Committee and the Tennessee Bird Records Committee (TBRC). Dan Mooney has been appointed as Chair of the Publications Committee. For the TBRC, Don Miller has been appointed to be a member, Dean Edwards as Secretary, and Kevin Calhoun as alternate committee member.

BIRD RECORDS COMMITTEE (TBRC): President Danny Gaddy asked directors to approve a small working-committee to examine the by-laws and procedures of the TBRC in order to make recommendations for improving communication between TBRC and TOS as a whole. Areas that need to be improved include moving paperwork through the committee in a timely fashion and submission of records; an examination of how other states' records committees operate would also be helpful in improving procedures. Chuck Nicholson stated that the president currently has the authority to make short-term adjustments, but Danny would still like a vote for "will of the body" to approve the formation of a working committee to examine TBRC procedures. The directors unanimously approved such formation.

Danny will also be forming a working committee to develop ways of increasing membership, involving youth, and sharing information among chapters, as well as to make recommendations about whether to allow vendor displays at state meetings.

COLLATERAL MATERIALS: Carolyn Bullock is no longer able to be in charge of sales of TOS memorabilia. Danny will appoint someone who can fill this position.

DIGITIZATION OF THE MIGRANT: (Dan Mooney/Dean Edwards): Digitization is complete, and copies are available for purchase. A complete Table of Contents is forthcoming. The committee is still in the process of separating each issue into individual articles and would welcome help from anyone who has some time and access to Adobe Acrobat (the standard edition, not just the free Reader). Because each file will still be relatively large, the text will not be searchable through Google and other standard web search-engines, but the committee has approached the SORA (Searchable Ornithological Research Archives) database about indexing *The Migrant* and including it alongside *The Auk*, *The Condor*, *The Wilson Bulletin*, and other prominent ornithological journals. This would make the contents of *The Migrant* fully searchable and accessible to researchers over the internet.

TOS WEBSITE: Chuck Nicholson repeated his request for bird-finding articles to post on the website. Many visitors from within Tennessee and out-of-state are using these articles, and they often email Chuck to let him know how useful these articles have been to them. East Tennessee, and the Knoxville area in particular, has lots of good bird-finding articles, but the same is not true for the rest of the state. Chuck is willing to offer assistance to folks who are interested in writing up submissions. It is not necessary to include pictures of the site; these can be added later.

THE MIGRANT: Editor Chris Welsh stated that he needs more article submissions. More reviewers—especially women—are needed. We are on track to print five issues this year; March 2005 was published several weeks ago, and June 2005 came out last week.

OLD BUSINESS: No old business was discussed.

NEW BUSINESS: Charlie Muise suggested that TOS not schedule its Spring/Fall Meetings on the same weekends as the Roan Mountain Naturalists' Rally, as this limits the ability of some members to come to state meetings.

TOS Fall Meeting: The Knoxville Chapter has agreed to host the meeting if no one else can, but would really like a group in Middle or West Tennessee to host the meeting. The date has not been set.

TOS Winter Meeting: not set yet

TOS Spring 2006 Meeting: The date has not been set, but the meeting will be in Bristol.

The meeting adjourned at 4:30 p.m.

MINUTES OF THE TOS ANNUAL MEETING

President Danny Gaddy called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. The president thanked the members of the Nashville Chapter for planning an excellent spring meeting.

Treasurer Mac McWhirter reported on the 2005 membership and finances. In 2005 there were 815 memberships. This is up for the first time in 4 years. This increase in membership was unexpected; a slight decrease had been projected due to the increase in membership dues. TOS had revenues of \$15,000 and expenses of nearly \$14,000, leaving a \$1,500 surplus. Investments total \$213,000. The digitization of *The Migrant* has been completed under-budget.

The president gave a summary of the business meeting:

Appointments to Tenn. Bird Record Committee (TBRC): Don Miller, Kevin Calhoun (alternate), Dean Edwards, secretary

Formation of a working committee to improve the function of TBRC, examining the following problems:

1. No one is submitting records
2. Consideration of record submissions in timely fashion
3. Determine way to standardize what needs to be submitted
4. Improve communication between committee and people who submit records and between committee and TOS at large

Nominations for President-Elect and Secretary: The Nominating Committee presented Richard Connors as their nomination for President-Elect and Laura McCall for Secretary. The floor was opened to further nominations; none were received. Dan Mooney made the motion to close nominations. The nominees were elected unanimously by the membership.

Digitization of *The Migrant*: The Publications Committee demonstrated the digitized *Migrant* for the membership. President Gaddy thanked the committee (Mike Roedel, Dan Mooney, Chris Welsh, Teresa Graham, Chuck Nicholson, and Wallace Coffey) for their outstanding work. Chuck Nicholson stated that an online version is in the works, but that separating each issue into individual articles is very labor-intensive. Volunteers are needed to help with this process.

Charlie Muise pointed out the posters on display in the meeting room. These posters, created by 6th graders from three schools, are the result of a Cats Indoors! contest sponsored by the Knoxville Chapter to bring awareness to the threat outdoor cats pose to wildlife, as well as to the fact that keeping cats indoors is healthier for cats. The Knoxville Chapter plans to host a contest next year and would like other chapters to do the same. At the Spring Meeting, we could select "statewide winners" from the winners of chapter contests.

The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m. and was followed by an informative and inspiring presentation by Ivory-billed Woodpecker searcher Bobby Harrison.

2006 TRADITIONAL SPRING COUNTS

This report summarizes the traditional spring bird counts that are typically run on dates other than the North American Migration Count date, which is always the second Saturday in May. These counts sometimes cover more than one county and sometimes more than one day. This year's seven counts produced 202 species (Table 1). The weather for the counts this year was mostly cool to mild, with some counts experiencing fog in the morning and some counts experiencing gusty winds. The most unusual species for these counts was a Black-throated Sparrow, originally found by Morris Williams in Lincoln County in November 2005. Temperatures ranged from 40 to 76° F. Other notable finds included American Bittern, Little Blue Heron, Cattle Egret, Peregrine Falcon, Virginia Rail, Sandhill Crane, Upland Sandpiper, Dunlin, Northern Saw-whet Owl, Scissor-tailed Flycatcher, Bewick's and Sedge Wrens, Hermit Thrush, Orange-crowned, Swainson's and Mourning Warblers, Lark and Lincoln's Sparrows, Brewer's Blackbird, and Pine Siskin.

COUNT SUMMARIES

Columbia (Mayfield-Gray chapter)– 28 & 29 April: 0700-2330. Weather: 41-76° F. Highlights of the count included Little Blue Heron, Bald Eagle, 9 species of waders, Barn Owl, Loggerhead Shrike, Philadelphia Vireo, Red-breasted Nuthatch, Golden-winged Warbler, and Fox Sparrow. Observers: Bobby Brown, Janet Brown, Phyllis Coble, Tommy Edwards (compiler: 896 Iron Bridge Rd., Columbia, TN 38401; (Tommy.Edwards@state.tn.us), Mrs. Guschke, Dr. William Jernigan, Dr. Allyn Lay, Bedford Lochridge, and Cleo Mayfield.

Elizabethton – 29 April; 0430-2145. Weather: clear to partly cloudy, with winds E-SE 5-20+ mph; 40-73° F. This was the 63rd consecutive spring count conducted by the Herndon chapter. The count area covers Carter County plus parts of adjacent Johnson, Sullivan, Unicoi, and Washington counties. The species total this year of 145 was right on the average of the previous 20 years (144.9). Notable sightings included Green-winged Teal, 8 Ruffed Grouse, Peregrine Falcon, Virginia Rail, Caspian and Forster's Terns, Northern Saw-whet Owl, 8 Least Flycatchers, all 6 possible vireos, Golden-winged Warbler, Swainson's Warbler, and Bobolink. Noticeably absent was Summer Tanager. Notable finds for this count included Common Loon (first record since 1994), American Bittern, Bald Eagle, Sora, Sandhill Crane (probably the first record ever for this count), 8 species of shorebirds (which included 75 Willets; this total is a record high count for East Tennessee), Eurasian Collared-Dove (second time recorded on this count), Bank Swallow, 31 warbler species (including Orange-crowned Warbler, 15 Northern Waterthrushes, and Wilson's Warbler but missing Bay-breasted and Canada Warblers), and 26 Baltimore Orioles. Species noticeably missed on the count were Sharp-shinned Hawk, Great Horned Owl, Whip-poor-will, Red-headed Woodpecker, Loggerhead Shrike (last recorded on this count in 1998), Fish Crow (despite being found on Ft. Loudon Lake throughout spring and early summer), Gray-cheeked Thrush, and Bobolink. 2006 TENNESSEE SPRING NORTH AMERICAN MIGRATION COUNT

This was the tenth consecutive year for the Tennessee Spring North American Migration Count (NAMC). Data were recorded by 145 observers from 16 counties this year, producing 208 species (10 year average is 205) and 43,079 individuals (Table 1). The birds / party hour ratio of 103.4 was well above the average for the last 9 counts (95.2). The weather was generally mild across the state, but almost every count experienced some windy conditions. Temperatures ranged from 41-78° F. No new species were recorded for the third straight year, leaving the all-time species total for the count at 258.

Highlights for the count included American White Pelican, Least Bittern, King Rail, Common Moorhen, Sandhill Crane (2nd count record), Dunlin, Yellow-bellied Flycatcher (2nd count record), Western Kingbird, Scissor-tailed Flycatcher, seven species of vireos including Bell's, Bewick's Wren, 36 species of warblers (with Orange-crowned being the only species missed), and Lark Sparrow. The following species were recorded in record high numbers for this count: Pied-billed Grebe, Least Bittern, Cooper's Hawk, Red-tailed Hawk, Peregrine Falcon, Chuck-will's-widow, Eastern Wood-Pewee, Eastern Phoebe, Carolina Chickadee, Mourning Warbler, and Summer Tanager. The following species were recorded in record low numbers for this count: Cattle Egret, Barn Swallow, and Savannah Sparrow. Lincoln's Sparrow was missed for the first time in 10 years.

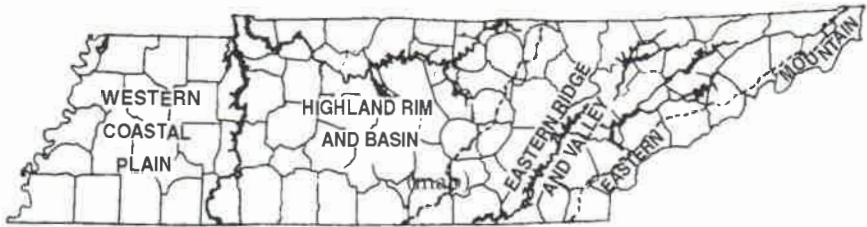

THE SUMMER SEASON

1 JUNE - 31 JULY 2006

This summer was hot and rather dry. July was the more extreme of the two months in this period. Little comment was received concerning nesting productivity, but the limited opinions indicated that most breeding activities were successful.

A few non-breeding waterfowl summered in the state. Anhingas may have nested in Dyer County. Significant breeding records came from waterbird rookeries on Woods Reservoir and Cherokee Lake. Little Blue Heron (and possibly Great Egret) nested at the former site, while at the latter Double-crested Cormorants and Great Egrets were found nesting. Possible nesting of Soras was reported from Shady Valley. Late north-bound shorebirds nearly overlapped with the early south-bound ones.

Nesting Scissor-tailed Flycatchers reappeared at recent breeding sites in three regions. Western Kingbirds nested again in Shelby County. Sedge Wrens were found at a site in White County where breeding has occurred recently. Magnolia Warblers and a Yellow-rumped Warbler tantalized observers on Roan Mountain. Several new populations of Henslow's Sparrows were found in the middle two regions of the state. Continued possible breeding by Bobolinks occurred in the upper Ridge and Valley.

WESTERN COASTAL PLAIN REGION — This was a dry summer in the region, with few rarities found. Six species of ducks, besides Wood Duck and Mallard, apparently summered at White Lake Refuge in the northwest part of the state. A pair of Anhingas were noted there also, along with a young bird which suggests local breeding. Continuing a trend of recent years, Scissor-tailed Flycatchers and Western Kingbirds nested successfully in Shelby County.

CUMBERLAND PLATEAU/RIDGE & VALLEY REGION — Temperatures in June were near normal, while July was hotter than normal. Rainfall was below average for both months. Although conditions were not always comfortable this summer, birders who spent time in the field were well rewarded.

Investigation of a waterbird colony on an island in Cherokee Lake (known to local boaters as "Bird Island") yielded moderate numbers of nesting Double-crested Cormorants, Great Blue Herons, and Black-crowned Night-Herons, with a smaller number of nesting Great Egrets. This is just the second confirmed breeding record by Great Egrets in the region. The nesting there of cormorants adds to the small number of recent breeding sites in the state for this species, as well.

Notable numbers of visiting waders were reported this summer, highlighted by a Wood Stork at Rankin Bottoms that lingered well into autumn. A farm pond in Washington County hosted single drake Blue-winged and Green-winged Teal all summer, plus had a one-day visit by a hen Hooded Merganser. A King Rail found dead in Knoxville was unexpected, to say the least. Scissor-tailed Flycatchers returned to two nesting sites in the southern part of the region, with breeding reported again at one site. Shrikes received little mention, but deserve closer scrutiny. Passerines restricted to the higher elevations of the Cumberlands were reported from two widely separated sites. A remarkable concentration of Henslow's Sparrows was found in Cumberland County. Bobolinks returned to a possible nesting site in Washington County.

INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

The Migrant records observations and studies of birds in Tennessee and adjacent areas.

SUBMISSIONS: The original and two copies of the manuscript should be sent to the Editor: Christopher J. Welsh, 5337 Hickory Hollow Road, Knoxville, TN 37919. Manuscripts that have been published in other journals should *not* be submitted. Electronic copies on disk or sent by e-mail to <cwelsh@utk.edu> are greatly appreciated.

MATERIAL: The subject matter should relate to some phase of Tennessee ornithology. It should be original, factual, concise, and scientifically accurate.

STYLE: Both articles and short notes are solicited; recent issues of *The Migrant* should be used as a guide in the preparation of manuscripts. Where more detail is needed, reference should be made to the *CBE Style Manual*; this book is available at many public libraries and from the Council of Biology Editors, Inc., 111 East Wacker Drive, Suite 3200, Chicago, IL 60601-4298.

COPY: Manuscripts should be typed *double-spaced* on 8.5 x 11" paper with adequate margins for editorial notations. Tables and figures should be prepared on separate sheets with appropriate headings; see *CBE Style Manual* for examples of appropriate form for tables. Photographs intended for reproduction should be sharp with good contrast on glossy white paper; black-and-white photographs will usually reproduce better than color photographs. Weights, measurements, and distances should be in metric units. Dates should be in "continental" form (e.g., 16 March 1997). Use the 24-hour clock (e.g., 0500 or 1900).

NOMENCLATURE: The scientific name of a species should be given after the first use of the full common name in the text. The scientific name should be underlined and in parentheses. Names should follow the *A. O. U. Check-list of North American Birds* (seventh edition, 1998, or supplements).

TITLE: The title should be concise, specific, and descriptive.

ABSTRACT: Manuscripts of five or more typed pages should include an abstract. The abstract should be less than 5% of the length of the manuscript. It should include a brief explanation of why the research was done, the major results, and why the results are important.

LITERATURE CITED: List all literature citations in a "Literature Cited" section at the end of the text. Text citations should include the author and year.

IDENTIFICATION: Manuscripts including reports of rare or unusual species or of species at atypical times should include: date and time, light and weather conditions, exact location, habitat, optical equipment, distance, behavior of bird, comparison with other similar species, characteristic markings, experience of observer, other observers verifying the identification, and reference works consulted.

REPRINTS: Reprints are available to authors on request. Billing to authors will be through the TOS Treasurer. Request for reprints must be made well in advance of printing.

SEASON REPORTS: Observations that are to be considered for publication in "The Season" section should be mailed to the appropriate Regional Compiler. Consult a recent issue of *The Migrant* for the name and address of the compiler.
