A SIMPLE WATER-DRIP

The accompanying photograph, as well as the sketch on the next page, shows a very simple water-drip mechanism used by Mrs. Peterson.

All that is necessary for this type of water-drip is to have a pet-cock soldered to the bottom of a can or bucket. Other banders prefer to use a syphon arrangement with a hose-clamp to adjust the flow of water.
