We do have the Pied-billed Grebes on the river (Delaware), but not the Horned. (Note: The Horned Grebe is found regularly on the Delaware River from Trenton southward in small numbers during Winter; it also occurs occasionally on the larger ponds when they are unfrozen; in migration, it sometimes occurs in large numbers in this area.--Ed.)

After a few half-hearted pecks, he (?) became very sociable; posed for photos by Norman Fisher, ate the tasty liver proffered by Jeanne Fluck, and took a refreshing frolic in the bathtub.
