CLOTHESPINS

for

BANDERS Mabel Warburton, W. Trenton Ave., Morrisville, Pa. writes that wooden snap clothespins are excellent to keep trap doors closed. "(Most banders use unwieldy rocks, or wire pins which are hard to place correctly.) Also, pin the doors open with snap clothespins when shutting the traps off for the night. Another use is to hold the collecting cage snugly against the trap while extracting the birds. Several of these clothespins fastened at strategic points with lengths of bell wire keep them handy."
