The Fish & Wildlife Service will show a film on the Whooping Crane.

Dr. Hubert Frings will talk on "The Language of Birds".

"Robin Populations and Insecticides" is the title of a paper by Dr. John F. Mehner.

Ralph Bell will describe a trap for taking adult Purple Martins.

Dr. Charles Blake will give a paper on moults.

Those are just the highlights. There's a wealth of material to be gathered at the meeting -- information and helps that will assist every bander to solve his problems.
