HELIGOLAND/CROW TRAP      The drawing shown below is taken from The Ring No. 56, August 1968, p. 143; the idea is presented by GATHERING CAGE      E.I. Gavrilov of Alma-Ata (USSR). The rear wall is plastic, transparent, and birds fly to it, flutter against it and slip down a narrowing funnel into the gathering cage itself from which they cannot escape back into the trap.
