HELIGOLAND/CROW TRAP The drawing shown below is taken from The Ring No. 56, August 1968, p. 143; the idea is presented by GATHERING CAGE E.I. Gavrilov of Alma-Ata (USSR). The rear wall is plastic, transparent, and birds fly to it, flutter against it and slip down a narrowing funnel into the gathering cage itself from which they cannot escape back into the trap. The idea seems simple but we have not seen it in use and hope it may be of use to EBBA News readers.
