Correction: In EBBA News 33(5):257, we listed Rc. 31. Ruby Crowned Kinglet # 109-30954. Thanks to Earl Baysinger's watchful eye, it has now come to light that this is another case of a misread band number. When removing the band, the finder obliterated the fourth digit in the prefix. The actual band number was 1093-30954, a Mourning Dove. Your editor profoundly apologizes for not "catching on" immediately....a Kinglet "shot?" Here's what Rc. 31 should have read:

31. Rc. Mourning Dove (Age-Sex?) 1093-30954. Banded by: USGMA Ellerbrock  
July 16, 1969 nr. Morris, Minnesota  
Oct. 15, 1969 found shot 2 mi. so. of Fayetteville, Texas.

48. 761-12304 Evening Grosbeak; AHY-F banded on April 17, 1970 by Fred Scott at Richmond, Va. Recovered on Aug. 9, 1970 at Lauzon, Quebec.  
49. 120-90536 Myrtle Warbler; HY-F banded on Sep. 28, 1969 by Jerome J. Barry at Rye, N.H. Recovered on May 13, 1970 at Farmersville Sta., N.Y.
