BANDED BROWN CREEPER RECOVERIES WANTED: Thousands of Brown Creepers have been banded at OR Stations on the Atlantic Coast, yet there appear to be very few recoveries. Kathleen S. Anderson of the Manomet Bird Observatory has requested that any bander having verified records of recoveries of banded Brown Creepers send them to her at MBO, Box O, Manomet, Mass., 02345, with a view toward summarizing what can be learned of Creeper migration from these recoveries.
