## PRICE CHANGES AND CLOSE-OUT SALE BY YOUR EBBA NET COMMITTEE

We plan to terminate the sale of our largest meshed nets. These are 12 meters long, have a 5" mesh, 2.4 meters deep, have two shelves, and are not tethered. Once our stock is sold we will no longer stock these nets. Therefore, we are offering them for sale at cost plus 5% (to cover postage). This amount is \$2.10 - the net usually sells for \$3.00. Get them while they last.

As we indicated in the previous issue of EBBA News, we have started to stock an altogether new net. This net is quite similar to our 12 meter, 14" tethered net, but it is much higher (about nine feet high) and has plenty of bag. The nylon thread is the same as our new nets, 70/d, and stands up well under extreme weather conditions. The price of this net is \$4.50 to sustaining members and \$5.00 to active members. Why not give them a try during the fall migration?

We have continually worked with our Japanese suppliers to improve the quality of our nets. Improved quality usually means an increase in price. Therefore, we would like you to note our prices as given below (new prices with asterisk):
