CUYAHOGA VALLEY NATIONAL PARK SPRING CENSUS, 2016

The 2016 Spring Census was held on 21 May, the latest day ever. Fifty-nine birders in 19 teams participated. The day was cloudy with drizzle like last year's but cooler with temperatures between 56 and 60 degrees. We found over 5500 individuals. That number is in the middle of the range of 2624 to 7787 achieved since counts of individuals began in 1995. The species count of 128 didn't compare well with last year's 138 and the record high of 145 set in 2010.

We again found both cuckoos, which benefitted from the periodic cicada hatch. Great Blue Heron numbers were down, probably because they've abandoned the Station Road rookery. Soras remained elusive if they were present at all. We saw two Common Nighthawks; they belie their name by being difficult to find for the last several years. Tufted Titmouse numbers remain similar to those of Black-capped Chickadee. (Before 2011 their numbers were considerably lower.)

We saw our first Cliff Swallow since 2001 but missed Brown Creeper for the first time ever. We also missed Black-and-white Warbler for the first time since 1991 and Wilson's Warbler for the first time since 1999. The one Orange-crowned Warbler was our first since 2005. Chimney Swift, Hairy Woodpecker, and Veery counts were on the high side; Yellow Warbler, American Redstart, and Ovenbird counts were low.
