- A. THE OFFICIAL PROCEDINGS AND/OR TRANSACTIONS OF THE ASSOCIATION.
- B. MATTERS CONCERNED WITH BIRD BANDING AS AN ART, PARTICU-LARLY THE IMPROVEMENT AND EDUCATION OF EBBA MEMBERS IN THEIR BANDING WORK. FOR EXAMPLE:
 - METHODS AND TECHNIQUES (NET SETS, TRAP CONSTRUCTION, IDENTIFICATION, AGING, SEXING, ETC.)
 - 2. NEWS FROM THE BIRD BANDING/LABORATORY; REQUESTS FOR HELP; NEW BOOKS; PERIODICAL REVIEWS; INFORMAL ARTICLES DEALING DIRECTLY WITH BANDING.
 - 3. FEATURE ARTICLES EMPHASIZING PROJECTS BANDERS CAN ENGAGE IN.
- C. TECHNICAL REPORTS ON PROGRAMS CONCERNED WITH BIRD BAN-DING AND ORNITHOLOGICAL STUDIES USING BIRD BANDING AS A PRIMARY DATA SOURCE.

SUGGESTIONS FOR AUTHORS REMAIN UNCHANGED, EXCEPT THAT WE NOW ASK YOU TO SEND US TWO COPIES OF YOUR MANUSCRIPT, IF POSSIBLE.
