Catches of the Victorian Wader Study Group in Victoria, Australia, in the period July to December 1981, were: 13 Pied Oystercatchers *Haematopus longirostris*, 15 Lesser Golden Plovers *Pluvialis dominica*, 139 Double-banded Plovers *Charadrius bicinctus*, 2 Red-capped Plovers *C. ruficapillus*, 32 Red-necked Avocets *Recurvirostra novaehollandiae*, 1 Ruddy Turnstone *Arenaria interpres*, 23 Eastern Curlews *Numenius madagascariensis*, 38 Bar-tailed Godwits, 48 Red Knots *Calidris canutus*, 79 Great Knots *C. tenuirostris*, 278 Sharp-tailed Sandpipers *C. acuminata*, 2479 Red-necked Stints *C. ruficollis* and 170 Curlew Sandpipers.
