THE CONSERVATION OF INTERNATIONAL FLYWAY POPULATIONS OF WADERS

As Me announced in Bulletin 47, we are publishing the proceedings of the Workshop on the Conservation of International Flyway Populations of Waders that was held as part of the 1986 WSG meeting in Edinburgh. The proceedings are being published jointly with the International Waterfowl Research Bureau (IWRB), as a WSG Bulletin Supplement and an IWRB Special Publication-

The proceedings are being edited by Nick Davidson and Mike Pienkowski, and will consist of four sections:

views of current knowledge migrations and breeding and grounds of flyway populations; - reviews of the wintering

- advances - recent in research on flyway populations; - approaches to the conservation of flyway
- populations of waders; an assessment of the future directions of flyway research and conservation.

The substantial editorial work in producing this Supplement is progressing well, and we aim to publish the Proceedings during the first half of 1987.
