

DELAYS IN MIST NET SHIPMENTS

Type A mist nets were in short supply from mid-August to mid-December, 1961, because of unusually heavy demand. We are trying to catch up with demand, but probably not with complete success in the next few months. A change in the way our shipments are handled in Japan will probably delay those which would normally reach us in late spring, but we believe that this type of delay is temporary.

NOTE: it is probable that I will be away from late June, 1962 through July. We very much regret that it will not be feasible to ship nets (or to correspond about them) during that time.

We stress once more the desirability of ordering nets somewhat in advance of the time they are to be used, when an early order is feasible. We try to be in a position to ship orders of any size immediately, but cannot always do so.
