## INSTRUCTIONS TO CONTRIBUTORS

All articles and notes must be submitted to the Editor in **duplicate, double-spaced** throughout, and on one side only of good quality bond paper. Leave ample margins on all sides, number each page, and avoid footnotes. Compose concise titles for tables and figures, but type figure titles on a separate page, not on the figure itself. Prepare figures at about twice the size (8 inches wide) that they will appear in print. **Support all illustrations so that they cannot be folded or bent in the mail.** For style throughout, consult a recent issue of *J. Field Ornithol.*
