

Update Your Field Guides

Each time we teach a course in ornithology, we find that the field guides we use have not kept up to date with the changes in bird names recommended by the American Ornithologists' Union. The 1947 edition of Peterson's *Field Guide to the Birds* is the most out-of-date guide since it does not include the numerous changes brought about by the fifth edition of the A.O.U. Check-List (1957). Recent printings (the 44th and subsequent) of Peterson's (Eastern) Field Guide rearranged the plates and page numbers, but did not correct the text. The newer field guide, *Birds of North America* by Robbins *et al.*, is quite up-to-date. All of the Audubon Field Guides by R. H. Pough were prepared before the fifth edition of the A.O.U. Check-List. While the Audubon guides contain many immature plumages and other unusual information of interest to ornithologists, they are relatively infrequently used

and no attempt has been made to update them.

The table that follows was prepared for our students so that they could update their field guides. In addition to the changes necessitated by the fifth edition of the A.O.U. Check-List, we have incorporated those listed in the Thirty-second Supplement to the A.O.U. Check-List (see *The Auk* 90: 411-419, 1973) and the corrections and additions to that supplement. We hope that you can benefit by its use as well.
