A cooperative International Shorebird Survey scheme has been organized by the Canadian Wildlife Service and the Manomet Bird Observatory since 1974 to obtain information on shorebird migration and to identify and document areas of major importance. This scheme provided much valuable information on shorebird distribution and migration throughout eastern Canada and the U.S.A., the Caribbean Islands and Central and South America. Any observer able to participate in regular counts of shorebirds during spring and autumn migration periods, as well as during the winter, is asked to contact one of the undersigned.
