Our 1981 Annual Meeting will be held at The Gateways Motel and Inn, 48th Street, Ocean City, Maryland. Ocean City, long on eastern shore hospitality, offers beautiful beaches, abundant waterfowl and other wildlife in the bays and nearby marshes, and ready access to Assateague Island National Seashore. The Gateways offer fine lodging, meeting rooms, and banquet facilities. Ocean City is accessible by major highways (Routes 13 and 50), by bus (Trailways), and by air (Ocean City Municipal Airport).

The weekend events will open with greeting old friends and meeting new, at the final Registration on Friday afternoon, 3 April. You will be free to stroll on the beach, take a look at the bay, or plunge into the heated pool at the Gateways. Friday evening features films on the ecology of Assateague and nearby wetlands, a reception, and Council Meeting.

Saturday afternoon will feature a final workshop session, and the Papers Session on banding studies and banding-related research. 
Sunday morning a box lunch may be picked up at The Gateways, then off to the field trips — a choice of Assateague National Seashore, or birding hot spots inland.
