## I. Non-passerines

Laysan Albatross. 1067-18184. Banded as L-U by U.S.F.W.S.-Hawaii at Midway Island, Pacific Ocean on 25 April 1978. Recovered at Kauai, HI on 12 April 1983. 5 years old.

Laysan Albatross. 1117-94214. Banded as L-U by Hawaiian Islands N.W.R. at Midway Island, Pacific Ocean on 4 June 1983. Found dead at sea, in Pacific Ocean approximately halfway between HI and mainland U.S. (Lat-Long 330-1401) on 25 January 1984.

Wedge-tailed Shearwater. 785-07502. Banded as L-U by U.S.F.W.S.-Hawaii at French Frigate Shoals, HI on 15 November 1980. Recovered at or near west coast of Guatemala (Lat-Long 142-0895) on 21 September 1982.

American White Pelican. 559-06054. Banded as L-U by Ronald A. Ryder at Riverside Reservoir, near Masters, CO on 11 June 1974. Caught in fishing gear at Lake Texoma, TX on 8 November 1982. 8½ years old.

American White Pelican. 559-12890. Banded as L-U by State of Colorado-Nongame (G.R. Craig) in northeastern CO (Lat-Long 402-1041) in July 1976. Found dead by Francisco Salguero near Las Lisas, Guatemala in January 1983. 6½ years old.

Black-crowned Night-Heron. 1037-14488. Banded as L-U by Ronald A. Ryder at Adams Lake, near Alamosa, CO on 5 July 1980. Caught in fishing gear at Villanueva, Zacatecas, Mexico on 24 November 1982.

Black-crowned Night-Heron. 1377-28294. Banded as HY-U by Charles H. Trost near Pocatello, ID on 6 August 1982. Found dead at Panuco, northern Vera Cruz, Mexico on 6 April 1984.

Trumpeter Swans. 519-72629 and -72675. Banded as AHY-F and L-M by U.S.F.W.S.-Alaska (Bruce Conant) at Minto Flats, AK on 11 August and 20 September 1983, respectively. Resighted at Burlington, WA on 31 December 1983.

(Lesser) Snow Goose. 807-40059. Banded as HY-U by Klamath Basin N.W.R. at Tule Lake, CA on 27 October 1966. Shot at Eston, SK on 11 October 1982. 16½ years old.

(Black) Brant. 647-61877. Banded as SY-M by Alaska Department of Fish and Game in western AK (Lat-Long 611-1653) on 11 July 1963. Shot at Humboldt Bay, CA on 18 November 1983. 21½ years old.

(Black) Brant. 647-60904. Banded as ASY-M by Alaska Department of Fish and Game in western AK (Lat-Long 611-1653) on 13 July 1963. Shot at San Quintin, Mexico on 21 January 1984. At least 22½ years old.

(Black) Brant. 647-62762. Banded as SY-F by Alaska Department of Fish and Game in western AK (Lat-Long 611-1653) on 11 July 1963. Caught due to injury at Puget Sound, WA on 29 April 1984. 22 years old.

Canada Goose. 558-12535. Banded as L-M by Malheur N.W.R. in southeastern Harney Co., OR (Lat-Long 425-1185) on 18 June 1969. Shot in northern Harney Co., OR (Lat-Long 433-1190) on 17 November 1983. 14½ years old.

Canada Goose. 558-44644. Banded as ASY-M by refuge personnel at Bowdoin N.W.R., Malta, MT on 7 July 1970. Found dead at same location on 17 August 1984. At least 16 years old.

Canada Goose. MY64 (neck collar); U.S.F.W.S. band number not known. Banded as AHY-F by Murray M. Gillespie on Hudson Bay near Cape Churchill, MB on 23 July 1984. Resighted by Billy and Brenda Dunbar at Gainesville, GA on 1 January 1985. (The Dunbars, who submitted this report, note that the bird was "of the eastern prairie population and should have been wintering in Missouri", i.e. in the Mississippi rather than Atlantic Flyway.)

(Dusky) Canada Goose. 658-07933. Banded as L-U by Alaska Department of Fish and Game at Copper River Delta, southern AK on 24 July 1970. Shot at Strawberry Point, AK on 6 October 1984. 14 years old.

(Aleutian) Canada Goose. 897-12886. Banded as AHY-M by Aleutian Islands Unit, Alaska Maritime N.W.R. at Buldir Island, Aleutian Islands, AK on 4 August 1974. Shot near Modesto, CA on 26 November 1983. At least 10½ years old. (Paul F. Springer, who submitted this report, notes that he and his co-workers resighted this bird 25 times "from winter 1975-76 through winter 1978-79, after which it apparently lost its color leg band.")

(Aleutian) Canada Goose. 1127-01061. Banded as HY-M at Buldir Island, Aleutian Islands, AK on 14 August 1980. Shot at W.L. Finley N.W.R., near Corvallis, OR on 15 January 1983.

Northern Pintail. 92-12751 (Japan). Banded as U-F by refuge personnel at Shinhama Duck Refuge, Ichikawa-shi (near Tokyo), Chiba Pref., Japan on 14 January 1982. Retrapped by Jonathon D. Anderson at Baskett Slough N.W.R., Polk Co., OR on 20 January 1984. (See also *Oregon Birds* 10:65-66, 1984.)

Northern Pintail. 100-17581 (Japan). Banded as U-M by refuge personnel at Shinhama Duck Refuge, Ichikawa-shi, Chiba Pref., Japan on 17 January 1980. Shot by Lou Federico in Colusa Co., CA on 18 January 1983.

Northern Pintail. 566-33906. Banded as AHY-M by W.D. Hawes at Lancaster, CA on 18 September 1958. Shot at Cottonwood, CA on 13 December 1983. At least 26½ years old.

Northern Pintail. 796-58632. Banded as AHY-M by Klamath Basin N.W.R. at Tulelake, CA on 8 September 1971. Found dead at Colusa N.W.R., CA on 24 January 1983. At least 12½ years old.

Osprey. 558-06923. Banded as L-U by R. D. Benedict at Brockatorton Bay, Worcester Co., MD on 16 June 1966. Found dead at Hampton, VA on 23 September 1984. 18 years old.

Osprey. 608-36027. Banded as TY-U by Jeffrey H. Hughes at Fern Ridge Reservoir, Eugene, OR on 10 July 1982. Recovered at Paredon, Mexico on 16 April 1984. 4 years old.

Osprey. 608-36028. Banded as HY-U by Jeffrey H. Hughes at Tetlin Lake, near Tetlin N.W.R., Tok, AK on 6 August 1983. Recovered at Davis Creek, CA in November 1983.

Bald Eagle. 629-15901. Banded as L-M by Alan R. Harmata near Conant Valley, ID on 7 June 1984. Found dead from electrocution near Hazelton, ID on 28 September 1984.

Cooper's Hawk. 585-66479. Banded as L-F by Charles J. Henny at Wallawa, OR on 13 July 1976. Found dead near Boise, ID on 8 May 1983; believed to have died about 1 month before recovery. Almost 7 years old.

Cooper's Hawk. 614-41129. Banded as HY-M by Stephen W. Hoffman in Goshute Mountains, northeastern NV on 24 September 1982. Found dead at El Dorado, Sinaloa, Mexico on 17 December 1982.

Red-tailed Hawk. 877-69652. Banded as SY-U by Fresno Wildlife personnel near Clovis, CA on 11 March 1984. Found on ground in weak condition near Rock Creek, BC on 14 July 1984.

Red-tailed Hawk. 877-77917. Banded as HY-U by Stephen W. Hoffman in Goshute Mountains, northeastern NV on 21 September 1982. Found dead at Apatzingan, Michoacan, Mexico on 20 November 1982.

Red-tailed Hawk. 877-86419. Banded as L-U by Bruce M. Wagner at Timpie, UT on 9 June 1982. Shot in Mexico on 21 January 1983.

Ferruginous Hawk. 877-81121. Banded as HY-U by Michael W. Perkins at Long Valley, NV on 7 June 1982. Found tangled in a barbed-wire fence and had to be destroyed at Diamond Valley, NV on 11 June 1983.

Rough-legged Hawk. 877-70071. Banded as L-U by David P. Mindell at Georgetown, on Kuskokwim River, AK on 22 June 1981. Found dead (partly decomposed) at Spirit River, AB on 1 June 1984. (D.P.M. notes that this record "indicates travel on the eastern side of the Rocky Mountains at a considerably far northern latitude by a Rough-leg reared in far western Alaska - relatively little is known about their migration routes.")

Golden Eagle. 599-29112. Banded and released as AHY-U by Kathryn A. Ingram near Apache Junction, AZ on 29 December 1978, following rehabilitation from head injuries (including permanent loss of sight in left eye) caused by collision with vehicle at Globe, AZ on 7 October 1978. Found stunned after colliding with fence about 64 km S of release site on 12 January 1982; released again in healthy condition at original site on 24 January 1982. (This record shows that a one-eyed eagle, provided during rehabilitation with opportunities to learn to compensate for its handicap, was able to survive in the wild for over 3 years. K.A.I. suggests that one-eyed birds therefore should not be considered nonreleasable.)

Golden Eagle. 629-07966. Banded by Sam Crowe in central TX on 7 January 1982. Retrapped as sub-adult female by Carter Niemeyer at Dillon, MT on 7 May 1983.

American Kestrel. 1143-28504. Banded as L-M by Stephen I. Rothstein at Goleta, CA on 6 June 1976. Found dead on highway at same location on 1 August 1983. 7 years old; no previous returns.

Peregrine Falcon. 987-38116. Banded as HY-F by C.M. Anderson at Cape Flattery, Clallum Co., WA on 3 October 1984. Found dead under transformer at Point Mogy, CA on 11 October 1984.

(American) Peregrine Falcon. 987-62178. Banded as HY-M by R.E. Ambrose at Porcupine River, AK on 10 July 1984. Retrapped at Cedar Grove, WI on 25 September 1984 and at Back Bay N.W.R., VA on 31 October 1984.

(American) Peregrine Falcons. 987-71217 and -71239. Banded as HY-F by R.E. Ambrose at Yukon River, AK on 8 and 13 July 1984, respectively. Retrapped at Padre Island, southern TX in October 1984.

(Arctic) Peregrine Falcon. 987-70503. Banded as ASY-F by R.E. Ambrose at Colville River, AK on 23 June 1984. Found dead at Leeville, LA on 3 December 1984.

Prairie Falcon. 987-63501. Banded as L-U by Bruce M. Wagner at Fish Springs, UT on 31 May 1982. Killed when struck by moving aircraft at Mountain Home A.F.B., ID on 2 March 1983.

Least Sandpiper. 1221-05435 (replaced by 980-74768). Banded as AHY-U by Terry C. Maxwell near San Angelo, TX on 7 August 1978. Renetted and rebanded at same location on 26 April 1984. At least 7 years old.

Dunlin. 702-99986. Banded as HY-U by P.R.B.O. at Bolinas Lagoon, CA on 29 October 1971. Renetted at same location on 28 November 1983. 12½ years old; no previous returns.

Dunlin. 851-38575. Banded as HY-U in AK in July 1978. Renetted by P.R.B.O. at Bolinas Lagoon, CA on 11 January 1984. 5½ years old.

Western Gull. 846-63356. Banded as L-U by P.R.B.O. at S.E. Farallon Islands, CA in 1967. Resighted at same location in 1983. Male, 16 years old.

Caspian Tern. 645-30729. Banded as L-U by L. Richard Mewaldt at San Francisco Bay, CA on 4 June 1971. Recaptured due to injury and died at Novato, CA on 20 August 1983. 12 years old.

Forster's Tern. 1023-14974. Banded as HY-U by L. Richard Mewaldt at Moffett Field N.A.S., Santa Clara Co., CA on 12 June 1972. Shot as scientific specimen at Kesterson N.W.R., Merced Co., CA on 12 July 1983. 11 years old (a longevity record for this species until exceeded by 1083-91268; see below).

Forster's Tern. 1083-91268. Banded as L-U by L. Richard Mewaldt at San Francisco Bay, CA on 12 July 1972. Found dead from disease (possibly botulism or toxic waste poisoning) at Tulare Lake Drainage Basin, CA on 19 June 1984. 12 years old. (L.R.M. notes that this is a longevity record for this species.)

Black Noddy. 1381-14224. Banded as AHY-U by Hawaiian Islands N.W.R. at Tern Island, French Frigate Shoals, HI on 20 October 1983. Caught in fishing gear at Nauru, Pacific Ocean (Lat-Long 003-1665) on 22 May 1984.

Blue-gray Noddy. 682-16903. Banded as U-U by U.S.F.W.S.-Hawaii in HI (Lat-Long 230-1615) on 30 July 1966. Recovered at same location on 11 June 1980. At least 14 years old.

White Tern. 852-75418. Banded as AHY-U by Hawaiian Islands N.W.R. at Whale-Skate Island, French Frigate Shoals, HI on 20 March 1984. Caught by animal at Oahu, HI on 5 April 1984.

Xantus' Murrelet. 802-01966. Banded as L-U by George L. Hunt, Jr. at Santa Barbara Island, Channel Islands, CA in June 1975. Found dead at same location on 4 April 1984. Almost 9 years old; 1 previous return. (G.L.H. notes that this is a longevity record for this species.)

Spotted Dove. 534-78049. Banded as SY-U by Charles T. Collins at Long Beach, CA on 26 April 1980. Found dead at same location on 12 April 1985. 6 years old; no previous returns. (C.T.C. notes that this probably is a longevity record for this species.)

White-winged Dove. 624-67369. Banded as AHY-U by Philip M. Walters at Tanque Verde Ranch, Tucson, AZ on 27 May 1982. Shot near Loreto, Baja California Sur, Mexico (725 km S of banding site) on 30 December 1983. (P.M.W. notes that this is the first recovery in Mexico west of the Gulf of California for a White-winged Dove banded in Tucson.)

Mourning Dove. 1443-49178. Banded as AHY-M by Philip M. Walters at Tucson, AZ on 26 April 1984. Shot at Mica Peak, near Spokane, WA (1,850 km N of banding site) on 9 September 1984.

Common Barn-Owl. 646-10705. Banded as L-U by John W. Flavin at Morro Bay, CA on 15 April 1961. Recovered near banding location on 3 June 1984. 23 years old; no previous returns.

Common Barn-Owl. 727-00713. Banded as AHY-F by Carl D. Marti at Clearfield, UT on 3 May 1977. Recaptured by hand in nest at same location on 16 December 1983. At least 7½ years old; many previous returns. (C.D.M. notes that this bird nested successfully at the banding site each year from 1977 through 1983.)

Common Barn-Owl. 877-39819. Banded and released as HY-F by Kathryn A. Ingram near Granite Reef Dam, near Mesa, AZ on 21 July 1979; bird was a hand-reared nestling originally from Phoenix, AZ. Found dead at Caborca, Sonora, Mexico on 29 October 1980.

Common Barn-Owl. 987-35955. Banded and released as HY-M by Kathryn A. Ingram at Glendale, AZ on 20 July 1979; bird was a hand-reared nestling originally from Chandler, AZ. Shot at Huatabampo, Sonora, Mexico on 5 May 1981.

Broad-tailed Hummingbird. X-20680. Banded as AHY-M by William A. Calder, Jr. at Gothic, CO on 11 June 1978. Recaptured at same location in 1984. At least 7 years old; several previous returns (see *N.A.B.B.* 8:172).

Hairy Woodpecker. 73-144758 (replaced by 901-52182). Banded as U-F by William H. Beatty at Oglebay Park, Wheeling, WV on 18 December 1974. Renetted and rebanded at same location on 14 February 1986. At least 11½ years old; 1 previous return.

Hairy Woodpecker. 821-53587 (replaced by 921-02057). Banded as AHY-F by Daniel DeJong at Island Lake, Marion, MT on 24 January 1978. Retrapped and rebanded at same location on 26 January 1983. At least 5½ years old; no previous returns.

Olive-sided Flycatcher. 1101-34522. Banded as AHY-M by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 16 July 1977. Renetted at same location on 27 July 1983. At least 7 years old; 3 previous returns. (P.R.B.O. personnel note that this probably is a longevity record for this species.)

Ash-throated Flycatcher. 1171-28330. Banded as AHY-M by David R. Bontrager at Starr Ranch Audubon Sanctuary, Trabuco Canyon, CA on 25 May 1975. Resighted at same location from April to June 1983. At least 9 years old; 7 previous returns (see *N.A.B.B.* 8:42 and 9:15).

Horned Lark. 1191-28031 (replaced by 1241-41254). Banded as AHY-M by Van A. Truan at Pueblo West, Co on 6 May 1978. Renetted and rebanded at same location on 31 May 1983. At least 6 years old; no previous returns.

Horned Lark. 1191-28182 (replaced by 1241-41243). Banded as AHY-M by Van A. Truan at Pueblo West, CO on 2 August 1976. Renetted and rebanded at same location on 25 June 1983. At least 8 years old; 2 previous returns.

Steller's Jay. 963-71503 (replaced by 1423-82404). Banded as AHY-U by Michael P. Yoder-Williams at Sagehen Creek Field Station, Nevada Co., CA on 29 April 1976. Retrapped and rebanded at same location on 26 February 1983. Male, at least 7½ years old.

Scrub Jay. 873-89335. Banded as AHY-M by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 25 May 1976. Retrapped at same location on 27 February 1984. At least 8½ years old; several previous returns.

Scrub Jay. 873-89397. Banded as AHY-U by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 20 September 1977. Retrapped at same location on 27 January 1984. Female, at least 7½ years old; several previous returns.

Scrub Jay. 1003-39212. Banded as AHY-U by Donald E. Payne at Eugene, OR on 27 January 1975. Retrapped at same location on 2 February 1985. Female, at least 10½ years old; 2 previous returns.

Scrub Jay. 1013-22115. Banded as HY-U by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 31 July 1973. Retrapped at same location on 5 June 1984. Male, 11 years old; several previous returns.

Black-capped Chickadee. 1520-67753. Banded as AHY-M by Kathryn B. Burk at Seventeen Mile Creek, northwestern MT on 8 June 1979. Recaptured at same location on 30 August 1984. At least 6 years old; 2 previous returns.

Bridled Titmouse. 1470-81145. Banded as AHY-U by Sally H. Spofford at Rancho-Aguila, Portal, AZ on 9 January 1979. Retrapped at same location on 11 January 1983. At least 4½ years old; no previous returns.

Bewick's Wren. 900-03587. Banded as AHY-F by William B. Tyler at Long Marine Laboratory, Santa Cruz, CA on 8 May 1979. Renetted at same location on 13 April 1983. At least 5 years old.

Wrentit. 78-30522. Banded as AHY-U by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 28 July 1973. Resighted at same location on 11 March 1984. Male, at least 11½ years old; 3 previous returns.

Wrentit. 78-31407. Banded as AHY-U by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 9 March 1976. Resighted at same location on 11 January 1985. Male, at least 9½ years old; several previous returns.

Wrentit. 78-31581. Banded as AHY-U by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 20 January 1976. Resighted at same location on 26 July 1984. Female, at least 9 years old; several previous returns.

Wrentit. 78-42831. Banded as AHY-U by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 10 February 1977. Resighted at same location on 11 January 1985. Female, at least 8½ years old; several previous returns.

Cedar Waxwing. 1291-03177. Banded as AHY-U by P.R.B.O. at S.E. Farallon Islands, CA on 25 October 1984. Killed by cat at Stinson Beach, Marin Co., CA in same month.

Hutton's Vireo. 1440-92440. Banded as HY-U by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 28 June 1977. Renetted at same location on 31 December 1983. 6½ years old; several previous returns. (P.R.B.O. personnel note that this probably is a longevity record for this species.)

Northern Waterthrush. 870-57520. Banded as AHY-F by Kathryn B. Burk at Seventeen Mile Creek, northwestern MT on 1 July 1978. Recaptured at same location on 11 July 1984. At least 7 years old; 3 previous returns.

Common Yellowthroat. 1340-73115. Banded as AHY-M by William B. Tyler at Long Marine Laboratory, Santa Cruz, CA on 5 June 1979. Renetted at same location on 20 April 1983. At least 5 years old.

Western Tanager. 1291-03040. Banded as HY-M by P.R.B.O. at S.E. Farallon Islands, CA on 25 September 1983. Found dead at Mazatlan, Sinaloa, Mexico on 11 February 1984.

Northern Cardinal. 66-165572. Banded as AHY-M by Sally H. Spofford on 9 January 1979. Found dying with eye lesions at same location on 25 July 1983. At least 5 years old.

Black-headed Grosbeak. 941-00335. Banded as ASY-M by Philip M. Walters at Tucson, AZ on 7 August 1983. Found dead by Jedi Rupe (Idaho Department of Fish and Game) at Meridian, ID (1,310 km N of banding site) on 13 May 1984.

Lazuli Bunting. 1510-83264. Banded as ASY-M by Merlin L. Killpack at Ogden, UT on 10 May 1979. Renetted at same location on 25 May 1984. At least 7 years old.

Green-tailed Towhee. 881-39808. Banded as HY-U by Mrs. A. M. Mery in Gunnison Co., CO on 9 July 1978. Renetted at same location on 23 June 1983. Female, 5 years old; 1 previous return.

Green-tailed Towhee. 881-39824 (replaced by 891-01032). Banded as HY-U by Mrs. A. M. Mery in Gunnison Co., CO on 23 July 1978. Renetted and rebanded at same location on 18 September 1983. Female, 5 years old; no previous returns.

Brown Towhee. 772-22449. Banded as HY-M by L. Richard Mewaldt at San Jose, CA on 12 July 1973. Retrapped at same location on 11 June 1983. 10 years old; 5 previous returns (see *N.A.B.B.* 9:30).

Chipping Sparrow. 1600-67303. Banded as AHY-U by Mrs. E. R. Kaven near Glennie, MI on 14 May 1981. Retrapped by Billy Dunbar at Watkinsville, GA (approximately 1,040 km S of banding site) on 14 February 1983.

Vesper Sparrow. 1171-54964. Banded as AHY-F by Mrs. A. M. Mery in Gunnison Co., CO on 13 July 1978. Renetted at same location on 17 June 1983. At least 6 years old; 2 previous returns.

Lark Sparrow. 1191-28040. Banded as AHY-M by Van A. Truan at Pueblo West, CO on 1 June 1978. Retrapped at same location on 15 May 1983. At least 6 years old; 2 previous returns.

Lark Sparrow. 1191-28043. Banded as AHY-U by Van A. Truan at Pueblo West, CO on 1 June 1978. Retrapped at same location on 17 May 1984. Male, at least 7 years old; 3 previous returns.

Black-throated Sparrow. 1420-32985. Banded as AHY-U by Charles E. Corchran at Tanque Verde Ranch, Tucson, AZ on 15 March 1979. Renetted at same location on 6 June 1984. At least 6 years old; 3 previous returns.

Savannah Sparrow. 870-42570. Banded as AHY-U by Charles A. Hundertmark at Rio Grande Nature Center, Albuquerque, NM on 26 January 1980. Renetted at same location on 6 October 1984. At least 5 years old; no previous returns.

Song Sparrow. 78-30770. Banded as AHY-U by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 19 August 1975. Retrapped at same location on 25 January 1984. At least 9½ years old; 2 previous returns.

Song Sparrow. 78-31424. Banded as AHY-M by P.R.B.O. at Palomarin, Bolinas, CA on 20 April 1976. Retrapped at same location on 8 February 1984. At least 8½ years old; several previous returns.

Song Sparrow. 1221-41545. Banded as HY-U by William B. Tyler at Long Marine Laboratory, Santa Cruz, CA on 20 November 1977. Retrapped at same location on 23 November 1983. 6½ years old; several previous returns.

Lincoln's Sparrow. 860-16070. Banded as AHY-U by Charles E. Corchran at Tanque Verde Ranch, Tucson, AZ on 17 February 1977. Renetted at same location on 5 January 1984. At least 7½ years old; 4 previous returns.

Pine Siskin. 1480-86768. Banded as AHY-U by Ronald A. Ryder at Fort Collins, CO on 7 March 1982. Shot as scientific specimen near Mountain Park, AB on 25 June 1982; male.

Pine Siskin. 1500-86078. Banded as AHY-U by Sally H. Spofford at Rancho-Aguila, Portal, AZ on 25 February 1980. Killed by striking window at same location on 1 March 1984. At least 4½ years old; no previous returns.

Pine Siskin. 1530-58747. Banded as AHY-M by Mrs. A.M. Mery in Gunnison Co., CO on 5 June 1981. Caught by hand and killed in Chihuahua, Mexico on 23 January 1983.

Pine Siskin. 1570-08213. Banded as AHY-F by Mrs. A.M. Mery in Gunnison Co., CO on 31 May 1982. Found dead at Zaragoza, Chihuahua, Mexico in May 1983.

Evening Grosbeak. 861-00598. Banded as AHY-M by Martha H. Balph at Logan, UT on 13 May 1976. Retrapped by Alfred G. Larson at Boise, ID on 6 March 1984. At least 8½ years old.

Evening Grosbeak. 881-13879. Banded as AHY-F by Ronald A. Ryder at Fort Collins, CO on 27 January 1979. Recaptured at Boulder, CO on 7 June 1983. At least 5 years old.

House Sparrow. 1301-40571. Banded as AHY-F by Char Kelly at Budd Lake, NJ on 3 June 1982. Resighted at same location on 19 March 1986. At least 5½ years old; 3 previous returns. (C.K. notes that this bird had white feathers on its head, giving a spotted effect which persisted through several molts.)
