MINUTES OF IBBA BOARD MEETING 13 APRIL 1996 PATUXENT, MARYLAND

Call to Order. President Forest Strnad called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM. Attendees: Tom Bartlett, Betty Grenon, Forest Strnad, Darleen Ayres, Tom Little, Jerry Jackson, and Julie Shieldcastle.

Minutes Approved: The minutes from the previous board meetings were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report. The Treasurer's report was accepted. Bartlett has received a request from Terry Ingram for funds to cover a \$300 shortage from the costs of the October 1995 meeting. A detailed accounting for the meeting costs will be requested.

Membership Report: Membership Secretary reported membership at approximately 300. Jerry Jackson moved, with a second by Tom Little, to provide \$100 for computer preparation of the membership directory. Motion approved. Directories should be available at the October 1996 meeting.

Old Business: Terry Ingram reported by letter that 60 nets have sold, with a phone order for eight more. He has received \$1940 for total net sales and has 105 nets of four sizes on hand. The

inventory is high due to receipt of an unordered shipment. An ad has been placed in *NABB*. The net account has a balance of \$219.94; monthly bank statements have been sent to Tom Bartlett, treasurer.

New Business: The fall meeting will be in Fayetteville, Arkansas, on 25-26 October 1996. It will be sponsored jointly by Kim Smith, University of Arkansas, and the Arkansas Audubon Society. Possible speaker will be Peter Stengel on amateur bander contributions.
