MacBand v. 4.0 S

New version of the only software for the **Macintosh** that stores, views, analyzes, and summarizes banding data, and generates **schedules acceptable to the Banding Lab**. A "stand-alone" application, **requiring no additional software**. Two formats available: S10 for monitors smaller than 13" diagonally, and S13 for larger monitors. Both come with an on-line "User Manual," tutorial and dual system of data entry—"band card" and "record card"—to increase data security. Automatic entry of data, with fewer errors than committed with manual logging, and analysis of distribution by season, returns, and age ratios. Provision for entry of aging, sexing, and identification keys and summary data on banding and status of species at your station.

New features in this release: on-line help, elimination of need to customize scripts and "purge" fields, addition of "user fields," provision for up to 81 locations and all 22 of the Lab.'s band sizes, default entries for repetitive banding of same sizes and at same location.
