"The work contains no technical matter, the aim being to supply trustworthy accounts of the life-histories of the birds in their relations to man. Mr. Nebrling has the instincts and sympathies of a naturalist. He is evidently a botanist and a musician as well as an ornithologist, and his descriptions of bird life are generally woven in with pictures of shady ravines and forest glades or flowery delis where the birds and plants and landscape are seen together as they are in nature. His residence in widely separated localities. Wisconsin, Illinois, Missouri, Texas and Florida-has enabled bim to become familiar with a large proportion of the birds he treats. emphasis is given to the economic relations and breeding habits.

"The illustrations, all of which are colored, show the birds in their natural surroundings, and are of two kinds: Plates of single species, mostly by Robert Ridgway;
and mixed plates by Mützel and Göring. Some of Mr. Ridgway's plates of single
species are among the most charming bird pictures I have ever seen."
