## BIRDS BANDED IN 2005

### The WBBA Annual Report

This year Walter Sakai has taken over the compilation of the Annual Banding Report for the WBBA. The first order of business was to convert submission to an electronic format. This seemed a prudent move, since most banders seem to have internet access, the Bird Banding Lab requires electronic data submission, and a myriad of other resources are now electronically accessible (MTAB, SORA, BIRDNET, and others.) To facilitate this change, we used AOU numbers to arrange the bird species names in this year's report, rather than the taxonomic sorting used in previous reports. In response to popular demand, we now have e-mail addresses for most responding banders; but to protect electronic privacy, we have not included them in the published report. WBBA members who need e-mail addresses for contact purposes may obtain them from the compiler.

Although many respondents applauded the conversion to an electronic format, the number of banders reporting their data to us did not markedly increase. We received 146 banding reports—only two more than in 2004—plus 41 reports of no banding in 2005 (no banding is also data). The banding number pales in comparison to the 220 or more reports received a decade ago. But in that it comprises nearly 25% of the total respondents for 2005, the 'no banding' group is also significant. Yet, this category appears not to have been mentioned, and may not even have been collected for previous reports.

There were 175,707 birds reported banded in 2005. This is 8053 fewer bandings reported than in 2004 (n=183,760) and nearly 40,000 fewer than the 212,405 reported a decade ago. Oddly enough, the total number of full species banded in 2004 (443) was the highest in the last ten years.

It is unclear what all of this means. The average number of reported birds banded by banders was 1203 birds. This is much higher than a decade ago, when the average was 800-900 birds per bander. It is likely that bird observatories and major research projects, each reporting as a single entity, are responsible for an increasing percentage of the birds banded. Also, we understand that the BBL now grants fewer banding permits than in the past. It may be that as older individual banders retire, they are not being replaced by newly permitted banders.

A decade ago, many of us were filling out banding sheets by hand. One would think that computers would lighten our load, but of course we all know that has not been the case. In addition, ten years ago we did not have micro-ageing, molt limits and a multitude of other information about each bird given to us by Peter Pyle and others.
